(4/28/25) Adolescent Health Substance Use & Prevention Virtual Mini Conference to be Held

Southern 7 Health Department and the Illinois Chapter, American Academy of Pediatrics invite healthcare providers throughout the region to join them for the upcoming "Adolescent Health Substance Use & Prevention" Virtual Mini Conference on May 9 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

The majority of young people are in good health. Yet some youth are at increased risk for behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes, such as high-risk substance use. Through this conference, participants will connect with experts and peers to:

- Describe trends in adolescent substance use in Illinois
- Explain screening using validated screening tools for substance use
- Discuss treatment and referral options
- Recognize the role mental health plays in substance use
- Identify community resources to address adolescent substance use
