(10/27/25) Update Regarding the Government Shutdown and Its Impact on Head Start and WIC from Southern 7 Health Department

Southern 7 Health Department is well aware of the concerns brought to families served through Head Start and WIC as a result of the recent government shutdown and continues to monitor the situation daily. We want to assure everyone that despite delays in the federal budget passing, services will continue as usual until we learn otherwise.

Earlier this month, we reported that WIC would be open and operational in Illinois with resources available through October. That deadline has been extended through November, 2025.

Regarding Head Start, we are expecting funds to continue through the end of this year. We have no planned program changes at this time.

WIC is a federally funded program through the U.S. Department of Agriculture that provides federal grants to states to safeguard the health of low-income women, infants, and children up to age 5 who are at nutrition risk by providing nutritious foods to supplement diets, information on healthy eating, and referrals to health care. WIC is available at each Southern 7 Public Health Clinic.
